Hearn Field Rules

Welcome to Hearn Field

These rules are so everyone can enjoy this beautiful space, and to preserve its unique character

This field is private land owned and administered by Haccombe with Combe Parish Council. It is a registered Open Space and is managed and maintained mainly by volunteers as a valuable amenity for the benefit of our community.

No person shall behave riotously or indecently on the field and shall not obstruct, disturb or annoy any other people including our near neighbours.

No person shall cause damage to any building, tree, hedges, plant, grass, fence, bench or equipment.

No person shall play any musical instrument or amplified music, singing or speech without permission.

No Religious or Political assembly, demonstration or rally are to be organised on the field.

All motor vehicles are banned from the field unless authorised.

BBQs, camping or overnight stays are not allowed.

No motorised aircraft, models or drones are allowed on the field at any time.

No person shall play or practice golf on the field.

Dogs are the only animals allowed on the field and must be kept under control at all times. Owners must clean up after their pets.

All litter is to be removed from the field.

The Parish Council does not accept any responsibility or liability for the death or injury to any person or animal upon the field. No responsibility or liability is accepted for loss or damage of property brought onto the field. All persons visiting the field do so entirely at their own risk.
